In the citation of patristic texts the editions used have generally been those either of J. P. In a number of cases the references are to well-known editions other than the above, and here the page has usually been set down after the editor's name. The abbreviations of the titles of journals etc. cited in the NOTES ON BOOKS should be self-explanatory.
